| <p>Brief Description</p> | <p>MMM is a collaborative mobile application for smartphones, tablets and PCs. Whether it is an alert or a planned mission, whether deployment takes place on an external site or inside a multi-story building, and whether or not blueprints have already been obtained, the MMM application allows to establish a detailed status report of the situation in a few minutes, as well as geo-locate it if necessary.</p> |
| <p>Main Functionality</p> | <p>The MMM application makes possible the planification of tactical aspects of the operation. The tool is designed for every component of the chain of command and operation (the authorities, crisis room, command post, operational factors in play, and external support).</p> <p>The MMM application is designed for collaboration: the application can be downloaded online and used for working together immediately without needing to be configured.</p> |

| | <p>Reliability whatever are the network connectivity: Withstand loss of radio coverage and network outages and ensure that every operator receives the same information at the same time.</p> |
| <p>Main Capabilities</p> | <p>Synchronized real-time information sharing</p> <p>Collect, identify, position all type of crisis characteristics and share on the go with FRs.</p> <p>Tactical operation planning</p> <p>Planification of operations in tactical way with all type of teams deployed on the field.</p> <p>Share tactical information</p> <p>Messaging, resources’ position and operational status.</p> <p>2D or 3D map.</p> <p>Objects positioning and identification.</p> <p>Security</p> <p>Through a “shared PIN code” generated randomly for each new operation, the application guarantees the confidentiality of information, while facilitating potential collaboration with external factors.</p> |
